CARING CONVERSATIONS



Discuss in your home or small group:

- Can you remember a time when you had an unexpected visitor? Tell your story.
- What would you have thought and felt if you were Mary and received the message from the angel Gabriel that you would give birth to God's son?
- In Luke, Mary serves as the model disciple. She is chosen by God and responds with confusion (Luke 1:29), questioning (Luke 1:34), and then acceptance (Luke 1:38). How would you describe your journey of faith in Christ?

DEVOTIONS



December 24 is the fourth Sunday in Advent. Continue to use an Advent wreath with four blue or purple candles and a white center candle, and use the following words:

Say: The fourth candle on our Advent wreath is the peace candle. There is peace in accepting God's call to trust God's promises and be a follower of Jesus. When Mary said, ". . . Let it be with me according to your word," she expresses a peace that passes all human understanding. [Light the first, second, third, and fourth candles.]

Read: Philippians 4:7. *And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.*

Pray: **Dear God, we thank you for the gift of your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, the one who comes to bring peace on earth now and forevermore. Amen.**

SERVICE



As a disciple of Jesus, reach out to people in need this week. Bring food or gifts to someone who is alone or in need of care. With your time or money, support an organization that works on behalf of the hungry or homeless. Find ways to be a servant of others in your own home during this busy time of year.
