Palm Sunday Litany (spoken from back of the church)

P: As the time approached for Him to be taken up to heaven, Jesus resolutely set out for Jerusalem. As He went along, people spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. When He came near the place where the road goes down the Mount of Olives, the whole crowd of disciples began joyfully to praise God in loud voices for all the miracles they had seen:

C: "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord!"

L: The crowds that went ahead of Him and those that followed shouted:

**C: "Hosanna to the Son of David!"
