Reports

Meeting minutes from April.

Building and Grounds: Warren reported on a product to put on the west slope by the parking lot. Grotrax is a bio fabric. Cost is \$719. Steve Jessen has used this product with success. Brian moved to order this and Tara seconded. Motion approved. Funds will come out of the Building and Maintenance budget.

The windows in the southwest classroom have been replaced. Some recaulking of windows and gutters and reattaching of siding caps on the parsonage need to be looked at. Warren and Chuck will look into that.
