Financial report: Greg reported that there were \$10,700 more in expenses in the month of July. One extra payroll period, day camp deposit for next year, catch up that needed to be paid to the pastors' pension fund. AED. And the parsonage kitchen. Council approved amount of food vouchers to go from \$20 to \$40.

Council has started discussions on the budget for 2023. Budget meeting for Council is October 20. Proposed budget will be sent out to congregation to receive by Nov. 6, and the Congregational Meeting is Nov. 20.
