From the Pastor – March 2024

Spring is coming and we are going to be preparing for Easter. As we move into this season, I am reminded of what Luther said about prayer, "A Christian without prayer is just as impossible as a living person without a pulse. The pulse is never motionless; it moves and beats constantly, whether one is asleep or something else keeps one from

being aware of it."



As I looked at the Tree of Life, I am reminded of the rootedness into the ground and with others, but always through prayer. As I sat teaching Confirmation the other day, we are doing the Lord's Prayer, I was reminded that the prayer itself is divided into two requests, the first three requests talk about God and the second four requests are about us. Compare that to the Ten Commandments and the two tables. The first talks about God and the second about our relationship with others. We are to be rooted in our prayers in God and then the other.

As I continued to ponder prayer and what that means, I moved into looking at the ministry we are offering and what can we move into in the future. How can

we improve and change what we do? How can you help in these ministries?

Currently we do not have a Care Ministry ... can we add Prayer Ministry into that and create something new?

We have a Membership Care ... what can we add or do in this ministry?

Eucharistic Ministry is currently not happening, but the need is not great right now ... but who can help when we need to activate it again?

We do an amazing job with Love Meals and funerals ... can we do anything else?

We have many opportunities, but need each of you to help with the ministry and to increase it in order to reach to each other and out into the world. The healthy church is concerned about those outside the walls and need to wrap the world in prayer. This is our call to action.
